Royal blue cardigan or sweatshirt (school logo preferred)
Dark grey/black school trousers (long or short) or grey skirt
Royal blue and white check summer dress (optional)
Thick black or grey tights (winter)
White / grey socks
Black shoes with sensible heels, suitable for school environment

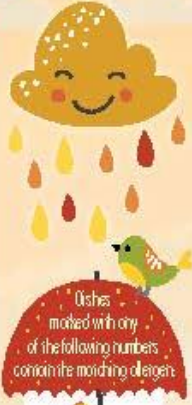
