Dear Parents and Carers,

As we start a new term, I would like to encourage all pupils to aim for 100% attendance and 100% punctuality. Attendance at school is incredibly important. When a pupil attends every day and on time, they do not miss any learning opportunities that we offer at Pelham. They also get to practice our school values, follow rules and routines that prepare them for their future and also get the opportunity to socialise and make friends.

I would like to remind all parents, carers and pupils that all pupils must arrive at school wearing the correct uniform every day. No jewellery, nail varnish or fake nails are permitted in school.
