Parent Consultation Evenings next Monday and Tuesday. Home and school working together in partnership helps to support your children on their educational journey here at Pelham.

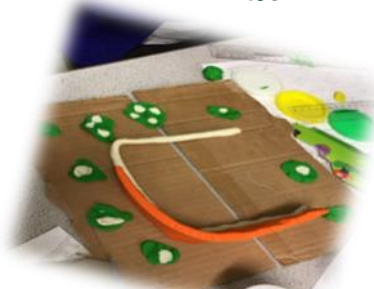
It is with great pleasure that I can announce the winners of our World Book Day Potato Competition on Page 3. Congratulations and well done to our winners!

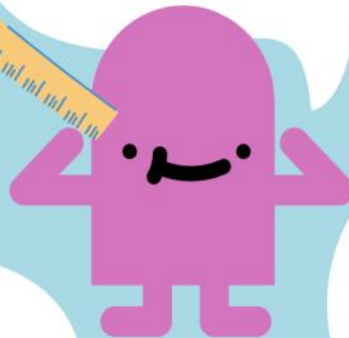
